

Westover Hills United Methodist Church Leadership Board Position Description

The nine members of the Westover Hills UMC Leadership Board shall:

1. Be professing members of Westover Hills UMC.
2. Serve a three-year term, unless fulfilling a lesser term when a position is vacated prior to three years.
3. Attend monthly meetings (of approximately 90 minutes) unless prevented from doing so by illness or travel. Some meetings may be attended virtually, but in-person attendance is preferred.
4. Set an example of growth in discipleship for our congregation and community by actively participating in the life of the church through our prayers, presence in worship and small groups, generosity in giving, service and sharing God's love with others.
5. Pray for the church and each other.
6. Respect each person on the team, value all opinions, and encourage frank and honest discussion, working productively through conflicts, and with confidentiality where appropriate. Once a decision is made by the group, we agree to support the decision even if we personally disagree.
7. Work as a team to establish and carry out the vision of the church along with associated goals, as well as allocating resources and conducting the administrative work of the church, thus enabling effective ministry by ministry teams and individuals.
8. Hold ourselves and each other accountable for continued growth as a disciple and for pursuing God's dream for the church.
